We are pleased to announce that Highley Parish Council has agreed to appoint Shropshire Youth Association (SYA) as our partner in starting up a new Youth Club in our village, our partnering package will include the following.

- A qualified "Leader in Charge" to run:
 - 39 club sessions (every week of term time)
 - 3 holiday trips/activities per annum.
- Managerial support and supervision.
- Employer's and professional insurance for the worker.
- Administrative support:
 - Youth club constitution,
 - * Policies and procedures covering:
 - Safeguarding and duty of care
 - Safe recruitment and equal opportunities
 - Grievance and disciplinary,
 - Health and safety
 - Free DBS checks for volunteers
 - Access to the SYA website which offers:
 - Your club an individual page
 - Registers
 - Secure cloud based information storage (GDPR compliant)
- Educational Visits Co-ordinator and a qualified Emergency Contact Officer to cover trips and visits.
- A suite of Training including:
 - Safeguarding,
 - Youth Work Training,
 - * Young Leaders.
 - Young people completing the Young Leaders' Training will be eligible to become part of our Charity's Young People's Steering Group.
 - This Group is often consulted by Local Authorities, CCG's and other strategic partners on key youth issues

In addition to our package there will be 2 youth worker training courses where we have Jack Noakes and Lee Jones who have volunteered their time and commitment to our cause,

they will be trained to level's 2 and 3 which will enable them to run their own sessions in the future and give the club a base to start from.

Our aim is to ensure that the club has a solid foundation so that the club can be built on with sufficient resources to plan and implement the ideas for its long-term future, and that it is a fun and safe place to visit and will be professionally run.
