03. Severn Centre - Future Options

Chair D.Tremellen welcomed Mrs.V.Hill – Chair of the Severn Centre Trust and Mr. S.Rolf – Chief Executive Halo Leisure to the meeting.

Mrs. Hill stated that the Severn Centre Trust had been working in partnership with Halo for the last nine years and after careful consideration by the Trust it had been agreed that the Severn Centre Trust Ltd should become a wholly owned subsidiary of Halo Leisure Services Ltd.

Mr. Rolf explained about Halo Leisure, its structure and working practices.

Mrs. Hill asked the Parish Council, as per the 10 year Management Agreement that was in place between Shropshire Council, Highley Parish Council and the Severn Centre Trust, if the Parish Council could confirm in writing that the agreement can remain in force under the changed circumstances.

It was **RESOLVED** to agree in principle to confirm that the contract would remain in force once the transfer had taken place. This to be put on the **AGENDA** for the September meeting for formal agreement.

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
